**Call for Papers**

Following the success of the second annual conference on Personal Tutoring in 2006, a third one-day event is being held on Thursday 3 May 2007 at The John McIntyre Centre, The University of Edinburgh. This year the event has an international dimension and will be co-sponsored by the National Academic Advising Association, NACADA and organized jointly with the London College of Communication, Southampton Solent, and Westminster Universities.

You are invited to submit an abstract for consideration by a peer review panel to be presented at the conference either as a paper presentation, workshop or poster. The conference themes are:

- Evidence informed practice on Personal Tutoring/ Academic Advising: UK and international
- Supporting student diversity: UK and international
- Resourcing Personal Tutoring/Academic Advising
- Assessing Personal Tutoring/Academic Advising
- Continuing Personal Development to support Personal Tutoring/Academic Advising
- Supporting dual honours students
- Supporting international students
- Peer support systems

There will be **ten minutes** for each paper presentation followed by 30 minutes discussion. Each session will have a chair, **please nominate yourself if you wish to be a chair.**

Workshops will be one hour

Posters should be of A0/flipchart size (1189mm x 841mm) to be put up in the morning and shown at lunchtime.
