- Video of a speaking engagement, OR
- Evidence of an academic advising program review/consultation.

Evaluations: received as feedback on speaking- or consulting-related events at the local, regional, national, or international level.

Two Letters of Recommendation: solicited from those who have direct knowledge of the applicant's expertise, education, knowledge of academic advising, writing and communication skills, and the ability to conduct a review or deliver a presentation.
