We will partner with the Advising Student-Athletes Community to help market this course to the NACADA membership. In addition, we will continue to work with members of N4A.	We will create a sub-committee that will focus on developing course material that works for new and veteran advisors. This group will consist of members from the NACADA NCAA Advisory Board as well as volunteering members from N4A. They will be the decision makers and, potentially, the facilitators for the course in Summer 2021.
