Dr. Michael B. Cosmopoulos is the Endowed Professor of Archaeology and Greek Studies at the University of Missouri-St. Louis. He is an elected Fellow of the Royal Society of Canada, of the Academy of Science St. Louis, of the European Academy of Sciences and Arts, and a Corresponding Member of the Academy of Athens. His research interests are the social, political, and cultural history of ancient Greece, about which he has published 16 books and over 100 scholarly articles and papers. He has excavated at several ancient sites in Greece and Ukraine and is currently directing the Iklaina Archaeological Project.

For his teaching he has been awarded several teaching awards, including the *Archaeological Institute of America Award for Excellence in Teaching* (2004). He has served or is serving as an Academic Trustee of the Archaeological Institute of America; Vice- President of the Archaeological Institute of Canada; member of the Managing Committee and former Chair of the Gennadius Library of the American School of Classical Studies at Athens; Vice-Provost of University College, University of Manitoba; President of the Classical Association of Manitoba; President of the Winnipeg Society of the Archaeological Institute of America; and honorary life member of the Archaeological Society of Athens.
