

## Application to review NACADA-produced books

Interested in serving as a reviewer for an upcoming NACADA publication? When NACADA produces a new book (usually one book per year) approximately a dozen NACADA members are recruited to review and comment on chapter drafts.

Reviewers selected are representative of the book's intended audience. Editors and authors count on reviewer comments to help then address reader needs. Reviewers provide thoughtful, constructive feedback. Reviews are "blind" in that authors do not know who reviewed their chapter drafts. Reviewers make notes about each chapter not on the chapter itself but on a different document. Comments address content, scope, organization, and quality of each chapter.

Reviewers typically have one month to comment on what was especially good, what needs to be improved, and what may be missing from a chapter. Sample reviews are provided so reviewers can see example the insights expected.

While NACADA does not pay reviewers, reviewer names & institutions are listed in each book.
